

## SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

- Mainly used for habitual actions and eternal truths.
- Adverbs of Frequency: always, often, usually, sometimes, rarely, never, every day, every month.
- Auxiliary Verbs: DO [I /You/We/They]  
DOES [He/ She/ It= Third Person Singular]

Spelling rules: Verbs ending in -y = (consonant + y) *try/tries* but [vowel+y] *play/plays*

### AFFIRMATIVE FORM

I

You

We + **WORK**

You

They

He

She + **WORKS** [“S” (or ‘es’) added to the verb]

It

### INTERROGATIVE FORM

**A + S + V (infinitive) ?**

**DO YOU WORK in an office?**

**DOES HE WORK in an office?**

NEGATIVE FORM

**S + A + NOT + V (infinitive)**

I                    **do**                    **not**                    work in an office

She                    **does**                    **not**                    work in an office.

[Contractions for negative form: don't/ doesn't]
