- **4** Mainly used for habitual actions and eternal truths.
- Adverbs of Frequency: always, often, usually, sometimes, rarely, never, every day, every month.
- Auxiliary Verbs: DO [I /You/We/They]
 DOES [He/ She/ It= Third Person Singular]

Spelling rules: Verbs ending in -y = (consonant + y] try/tries but [vowel+y] play/plays
